Safety Update In Glastonberry

If you have someone that comes frequently to your house (ie son, daughter, daycare sitter, etc more than twice a month) you may want them also to have a sticker. The purpose of the stickers are to allow people walking about to quickly and easily identify which cars are driven by people who are part of the Glastonberry "family" and which are just passing through or visiting. Please place them close to your license plate to aid in identification. Please note that if you do not want to permanently affix the decals, you can put rubber cement or a magnet on the back and stick it on.
